Rules:

2 Lowest scoring players from previous year are exempt for the following year.

Previous year State Mid-Amateur Champions are exempt.

Team Captains are exempt.

Players who turn 25 by July 27, 2017 are eligible to play in the 2017 event.

Players who turn 50 by July 27, 2017 are eligible to play in the Senior portion of the 2017 event.

If 2 senior players do not receive an exemption via exemptions or placing in the first 5-6 spots on a team, the captain is provided with Captain's Picks for their seniors.

A captain receives a captain's pick for any player on this list who declines their invitation. They are not required to invite any player any player who did not earn an exemption.

Every team is required to place 2 seniors in the top 9 seeds during each day of play of the event.

A player who does not earn an exemption will not replace another player who loses eligibility to play in the event.

The Points List for a state is determined by the organization which hosts the official State Amateur.

A player's state of residence is determined by the state amateur he participates in. If he participates in multiple state amateurs, then his home state is determined by the state in which he plays the most events.
